Membership Term

The 2005 i-SAFE Student Advisory Board will serve from January 1, 2005-July 1, 2005. Members who significantly contribute to the board may be asked to remain on the board for an additional one year of service. Future terms will be for a one-year term beginning September 1st.

SAB Meetings and Procedures

- **The SAB shall meet on the 15th of every month through June. Meetings will be held in the i-SAFE SAB members-only chat room.**
- **The SAB shall also meet by conference call once every quarter (four times) during the school year on the first day of the beginning of each quarter.**
- **Members will be notified of summer meetings, if necessary, by i-SAFE via e-mail and/or phone.**
- **Special conference call meetings may be called by i-SAFE, as necessary, and members will be notified via e-mail and/or phone.**
